### *IBAO Holds Fall Golf Day with Professional Golfer Richard Scott*

TORONTO, October 4, 2007—The Insurance Brokers Association of Ontario (IBAO) hosted a fall golf awareness day to give brokers a chance to get to know Canadian Tour member Richard Scott. IBAO announced last April that it was sponsoring the young Canadian Tour member for the duration of the 2007 golf season.

During the golf day, Scott gave the participating insurance brokers some golf tips, before playing a round with them at Club Link's Rattlesnake Point in Milton.

"IBAO is thrilled to be supporting such an outstanding young man," said IBAO CEO Randy Carroll. "We look forward to keep working with him as he continues to climb the ranks in the golf world."

Carroll said that sponsoring Scott was a perfect fit for his organization, as he is one of Ontario's most promising young athletes. IBAO is known to support community-related initiatives since insurance brokers are local business people who are very involved within their communities.

Scott, 23, turned pro last November after having won three of the past four Canadian Men's Amateur Golf Championships, becoming only the sixth player in 102 years to win three titles.

This summer, in his first season on the Canadian Tour, Richard Scott boasted two Top 10 finishes. Due to his performance, Scott will be granted exempt status on the Canadian Tour in 2008 and will not have to participate in the Tour's winter qualifying school.
