



CANADIAN CERTIFIED INSURANCE BROKER (CCIB)

The Canadian Certified Insurance Broker designation is the highest designation awarded by the Insurance Brokers Association of Canada. It is recognized by the profession as the ultimate standard of excellence. All insurance brokers should strive to attain this designation.

There is no formal course of study for the CCIB exams, however, a resource study manual is available to assist candidates in preparation for the examinations. The designation is intended to demonstrate the holder's practical competency gained through experience, rather than the successful completion of an academic program. A three month preparation time is recommended.

There are 3 examinations to complete. The exams test all aspects of property and casualty insurance, including the candidate's ability to do risk management analysis.

There is a three and a half hour essay-style examination testing practical application of technical knowledge to case study situations, and a two-hour short answer examination testing technical knowledge.

Upon successful completion of the two written examinations, candidates are eligible to attempt the survey examination. The survey examination can be completed in either a written or oral format. The written format consists of a 5-hour open book examination.

In the oral format, the candidate prepares an insurance proposal based on a case study provided to him/her. Following submission and acceptance of the survey, the candidate challenges a one and a half hour oral examination.
